## TRAVEL REQUIREMENTS

### **TARIFF**

Tourists can book a package holiday to Bhutan through both Bhutanese and International tour operators. The Royal Government of Bhutan sets minimum selling prices for packages to Bhutan and this must be paid in US dollars prior to arrival in Bhutan. The minimum daily package for tourists travelling in a group of 3 persons or Tourist more is as follows:

- US \$ 250 per person/night in high season (March to May, September to November)
- US \$ 200 per person/night in low season (January, February, June to August, & December)
  The minimum Daily Package Includes:
- All internal taxes and charges (including the royalty of US \$ 65)
- Accommodation
- All Meals
- All travel with a licensed Bhutanese Tour Guide
- All internal Transport (excluding Internal Flights)
- Camping Equipment and Haulage for Trekking Tours

Tourists travelling in a group of two persons or less must pay a daily surcharge in addition to the minimum daily package rates, if travelling alone, the daily surcharge is US \$ 40 for a group of two persons, the daily surcharge Is US \$ 30 per head. 
